RECYCLING

Clearwater has single-stream recycling, meaning that our recyclables don't have to be separated.

What can go in the recycling dumpsters?

1. plastics numbered 1-7 (exception: plastic bags and no styrofoam)
2. paper, including newspapers, magazines, junk mail, paperboard (cereal boxes, shoe boxes, etc.) no shredded paper
3. metal cans (tin, steel & aluminum; includes empty aerosol cans)
5. glass bottles and jars - no lids
4. cardboard - flattened (but no dirty cardboard...e.g., pizza boxes)

TVs: If you are disposing of a TV, schedule a pick up by calling Solid Waste @ 727 562-4920; then place the item by the garbage dumpsters the night before pick-up. On the last Wednesday of each month, the city accepts electronic waste at the Solid Waste facility at 1701 Hercules Avenue. Accepted items include: TVs, monitors, CPUs, cell phones, laptops, power supplies.

The county HEC3 facility at 2855 109th Ave. accepts electronic and chemical wastes Monday - Saturday from 7 am til 5 pm.
